Scholarship Terms and Conditions

Each year the International University in Geneva awards a limited number of scholarships. The scholarship program aims to support outstanding students from around the world in realizing their education goals and build their professional future.

This year the International University in Geneva has decided to award <u>scholarships</u> covering <u>40% of the total tuition fee.</u>

Students will be attached to the Administration an average of 2 days per week to perform various office duties in exchange of the tuition fee reduction. Scholarship does not cover related expenses (cost of living, books,..).

Condition to be granted the scholarship is that students apply for one of the following Bachelor programs at the International University in Geneva:

- Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)
- Bachelor in International Relations (BA-IR)
- Bachelor in International Management (BA-IM)
- Bachelor in Media and Communication (BA-MC)
- Bachelor in Computer Science (BSC)



Furthermore, successful candidates will have access to the exclusive services of the International University in Geneva:

- customized assistance in finding a suitable accommodation in Geneva
- personalized career counseling
- meeting with human resource representatives of multinationals and international organizations
- social events

The selection criteria include academic achievement and the financial need of the applicant.

Deadline for scholarship applications: <u>July 31st, 2016</u>.

Candidates can apply either online (<u>http://www.iun.ch/en-en/apply-online</u>) or by post by sending the following documentation:

- A motivation essay of max. 200 words (addressed to the attention of Dr. Claude Cellich, Vice-President of the International University in Geneva) explaining how their skills and past achievements will contribute to their future studies
- Curriculum Vitae
- Passport copy
- Secondary/High School Diploma and Transcripts in English
- Reference Letter from a professor or college counselor
- English test results of TOEFL, IELTS or Cambridge Advanced Certificate in English (not necessary for native speakers and for those who have studied at least 2 years in English previously)
- Proof of payment of the Application fee (non-refundable) of CHF 150.- (via paypal or credit card at http://www.iun.ch/en-en/admissions/payment)
